


## PRESIDENT'S CORNER

### TURNPIKE TUNNEL BIKE OR HIKE Saturday, May 15

When the Turnpike opened in 1940, it was known as the "Tunnel Highway" because it contained seven tunnels from east to west. By the late 1950s, the Turnpike was so heavily used that traffic congestion was a problem at the tunnels. The Turnpike Commission did studies and decided to bypass and close two tunnels located about 60 miles west of Harrisburg. Today, the "Abandoned Turnpike", has become a popular tourist attraction. The property is managed by "Friends of the Pike 2 Bike", a coalition of non-profit groups who eventually converted the 10 mile stretch into a biking and hiking trail. The property is officially closed to motor vehicles, but riders and hikers are free to use it. If you would like to participate in this adventure, meet us at 9 AM on Sat, May 15 (Rain Date - Sunday, May 16) in the parking lot at Doc Holliday's, New Cumberland. (Same location that our meetings are held.) We'll park east of the tunnels, ride 10 miles west to Breezewood, stop for lunch at a diner, then ride back to our cars. For those who would rather hike, it's 1 mile to the entrance of the first tunnel (this tunnel is over 1 mile long). Don't forget your flashlight. 



**SPRING ROAD TRIP ~ Saturday, June 5**


