DID YOU HEAR ABOUT IT?

Whenever we decide to head to the slopes, we expect to have a good time and a safe return.

The National Ski Area Association issued a list of rules which proved to be known as the

"Responsibility Code". The code below calls out the most important points which are easy to keep in mind when we are on the slope.

Over the years other nations adopted the rules which are posted in resorts all over the world in four languages- English, French, German and the native one.

Law enforcement in our country uses the Responsibility Code as a base for their decision.

Always stay in control, and be able to stop or avoid other people or objects.

People ahead of you have the right of way. It is your responsibility to avoid them.

You must not stop where you obstruct a trail, or are not visible from above.

Whenever starting downhill or merging into a trail, look uphill and yield to others.

Always use devices to help prevent runaway equipment.

Observe all posted signs and warnings. Keep off closed trails and out of closed areas.

Prior to using any lift, you must have the knowledge and ability to load, ride and unload safely.

Know the code. It's your responsibility.

Please take some time to think about the text above and go through point for point and you will conclude that every accident can be prevented by following the rules. (Reprinted from Eastern Pennsylvania Ski Council- Safety)
