SEVEN SPRINGS PENNSYLVANIA January 31-February 2, 2024 (Wednesday- Friday)

Are you looking for a mid-week getaway to chase away the winter blues? Join us for a bus trip to Seven Springs Mountain Resort only a few hours from Harrisburg, PA. Seven Springs is a beautiful area in the Laurel Highlands with primarily green and blue trails, but there are some challenging trails for the more advanced skier. We also hope to ski at sister resorts, Laurel Mountain and/or Hidden Valley.

Hotel lodging at the Seven Springs Resort, with two queen beds, is ski-in/ski-out. Seven Springs Resort has an indoor pool, shops and many other indoor and outdoor activities for an additional fee, such as tubing, hot tub, skeet shooting, roller skating, miniature golf, axe throwing, arcade room and the Trillium Spa. ATTITASH/WILDCAT, NEW HAMPSHIRE February 25-29, 2024 (Sunday-Thursday)

Join us on the magic bus to North Conway for 3 full days of skiing at Epic resorts in the White Mountains of New Hampshire.

If you've never been to North Conway, it is a very cool town with lots of restaurants, brew pubs, shops, and outlets. We are staying at the Fox Ridge Resort, where each room has 2 queen beds. Breakfast and WIFI are included, and there are an indoor pool and hot tub. Sea Dog Brewing Company is a 7-minute walk from our hotel. The bus leaves from Middletown, PA on the morning of February 25, 2024. It's about an 8 hour and 40 minutes bus ride to Fox Ridge Resort. BIKE, KAYAK, HIKE – NEW LOCATION August 5th, 10:00 am

Be the ultimate weekend warrior on August 5th as the Ski Club goes out and plays for the day.

We are setting up our base camp at the Falmouth Boat Launch (111 Collins Road, Bainbridge, PA 17502) as we explore the area on foot, in kayaks, and on bikes. Meet at the Falmouth Boat Launch at 10 am on Saturday, August 5th.

Kayakers can explore a unique phenomenon, the Conewago Potholes (look it up), where the river has carved fascinating forms in the rocks around the launch site. They are a very easy paddle from the boat launch. PA boat registration required.

Bikers can explore the 15 mile long Northwest Lancaster River Trail riding at their own pace and distance. Not only does the ride include sweeping views of the Susquehanna river, but also along the trail is the surreal White Cliffs of Conoy, and an eagles nest.

Hikers can explore the Potholes climbing among the rocks or hiking the Northwest Lancaster River Trail.

Can't decide? No problem, pick one to do in the morning, then enjoy a picnic lunch (grilled hot dogs provided by the ski club, please bring something to share) and then pick another fun activity for the afternoon.

BUFFALO VALLEY RAIL TRAIL RIDE

August 12, 10:30

On Saturday, August 12, Barb Crout will lead the third annual Buffalo Valley Rail Trail ride, starting at the **Jackass Brewery, 2268 Old Turnpike Rd, Lewisburg, Pa 17837 at 10:30 am.** Park across the street from the brewery. The Buffalo Valley Rail Trail is a 9.5 mile finished scenic trail that is visited by thousands of residents and visitors between Mifflinburg and Lewisburg with many trailheads, facilities and parking areas including a couple of breweries and an ice cream shop. The Buffalo Valley Rail Trail follows the route of a railroad that once ran from Montandon to Bellefonte in Centre County, crossing through Union County on an east-west alignment. The Lewisburg Centre & Spruce Creek Railroad was incorporated in 1853, and immediately faced the difficulties of the Civil War and the St. Patrick's Day flood of 1865.

PADDLE AND BREW

Thursday, August 17

Circle August 17 on your calendar for a leisurely afternoon paddle on the Swatara Creek, a favorite outdoor adventure near Hershey. The Swattie provides a gentle float between shaded banks, passing a variety of fishing holes, small islands and limestone outcrops. If you're lucky, you might see a few ospreys, bald eagles or herons along the way.

Meet at 1 pm at the Swatara Creek Park on Hanover Street in Union Deposit. We will offload our boats and shuttle vehicles to the takeout at Schiavoni Park in Hummelstown. Weather and water levels will determine the paddle information so check our Meetup, website or eblast for exact details provided by Dyan Yingst close to that date. Please bring your PFD, water bottle and snacks. This stretch is about 5 miles.

2024-2025 DUES INCREASE

At their May 31, 2023 board meeting, by a 2/3 majority vote per the SSC Bylaws, the SSC Board of Directors, approved increasing the dues by \$10 for Single Adult and Family/Household memberships. Following are the new rates **effective April 1**, **2024**:
