This western New York resort enjoys average annual snowfall of 180 inches and has snowmaking on 95% of their trails. There will be an optional day of skiing at the nearby Holimont Ski Area on Friday, February 23. Holimont, North America's largest private ski resort, is open to the public mid-week, with 8 lifts and 50+ trails, and has something for every level.

We will stay at the Inn at


