PRESIDENT'S CORNER

I hope everyone is having a great start to your summer. The Social Committee has organized a great list of deck parties, bike, hike and kayaking opportunities along with mini golf to help you enjoy your time outdoors this summer.

I am also reaching out to advise you that the SSC Board of Directors, by over a 2/3 majority vote, per SSC bylaws, at the 5/31/23 board meeting, voted to raise the SSC yearly membership dues. We will be adjusting the Annual Membership Dues from \$35 to \$45 for a Family/ Household Membership and \$25 to \$35 for Single Adult Membership effective the 2024-2025 membership year. The Junior Membership will remain the same at \$20. As in all other facets of business, SSC has experienced increased overhead costs over the last 19 years, more notably in the past two years. Over the past few years, most of our fixed expenditures have gone up along with the cost of food and services which affects the cost to SSC for the Get Acquainted Party and Holiday Party which are both free to our membership. After giving this much thought and discussion, the board found it necessary to make this adjustment. When thinking about this price adjustment, please consider the following:

- This is the first membership fee adjustment in over 19 years.
- SSC dues still provide its membership a great value for the price.

Notice of the increase in membership dues will be in the July and August Chairlift Chatter to notify the membership as required by SSC Bylaws. We hope the membership will understand the need for this increase in dues. This increase will allow us to cover the operating costs of our club and to continue operating the club at the same standard of service the members have come to expect. We greatly appreciate your continued support of SSC through this time of growth and change. Reach out to any board member if you have any questions or concerns.

I hope you enjoy your summer and hope to see you at one of our events.

Thank you for your patience as we continue to work out the details for the Seven Springs mini-trip. ATTITASH/WILDCAT, NEW HAMPSHIRE February 25-29, 2024 (Sunday-Thursday)

Join us on the magic bus to North Conway for 3 full days of skiing at Epic resorts in the White Mountains of New Hampshire.

If you've never been to North Conway, it is a very cool town with lots of restaurants, brew pubs, shops, and outlets. We are staying at the Fox Ridge Resort, where each room has 2 queen beds. Breakfast and WIFI are included, and there are an indoor pool and hot tub. Sea Dog Brewing Company is a 7-minute walk from our hotel. The bus leaves from Middletown, PA on the morning of February 25, 2024. It's about an 8 hour and 40 minutes bus ride to Fox Ridge Resort. The bus will take us to either Attitash (16-minute ride) or Wildcat (31-minute ride) on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday. **Attitash Mountain Resort** has 2 mountains, 68 trails, 8 lifts, and 60+ acres of tree skiing. **Wildcat Mountain** has 2100 vertical feet, great views of Mt. 2024-2025 DUES INCREASE

At their May 31, 2023 board meeting, by a 2/3 majority vote per the SSC Bylaws, the SSC Board of Directors, approved increasing the dues by \$10 for Single Adult and Family/Household memberships. Following are the new rates **effective April 1, 2024**

Single Adult - \$35 (individuals 21 years and older)

Family/Household - \$45 (one or two adults 21 years and older and all dependent minors under 18 years of age who reside at the same physical address)

Junior - \$20 (individuals between 18-20 years of age)
