PLEASE COMMIT EARLY TO AVOID THE CANCELLATION OF THESE TRIPS

The contracts we have this year are very stringent in their deadlines which require us to have a certain number of participants by unusually early dates. If we must cancel a trip by the due date because of lack of participation, we are still responsible for paying cancellation fees to the hotel, tour operator or airlines. Please commit early, so your club does not have to absorb these fees and that these trips can proceed as planned.

TRAVEL INSURANCE IS HIGHLY RECOMMENDED!

Attention trip participants, especially in light of recent unforeseen events, it is the responsibility of each participant to secure their own insurance based on their individual needs. If you have a pre-existing condition most insurance companies require you to obtain insurance within two weeks from the date you made your trip deposit (this may vary among insurance companies).

ATTENTION All SUSQUEHANNA SKI CLUB MEMBERS

Trip signup procedure for the 2024/2025 season.

Here is what you need to do:

- 1. Your Membership must be current and up to date in accordance with the rules stated on the membership application. Failure to supply correct, complete and accurate information will make you **ineligible** for a trip lottery should the trip oversell.
- 2. All Trip applications and deposits will be accepted either by U.S. Mail or in person at the Reveal at Boomerangs Tuesday May 7, 2024.
- 3. All mailed applications and deposits must be post marked **no earlier than Tuesday May 7, 2024.** If your application and deposit are postmarked prior to May 7, you will be **ineligible** for a trip lottery should the trip oversell.
- 4. So, go to www.skissc.com and click on trips. Select the trip(s) of your choice.
- 5. Print out the trip terms and application. Complete and sign trip application in full. Please note, by signing the trip application you are acknowledging and will abide by all of the trip terms.
- 6. Make deposit check payable to "SSC" and mail completed trip application and deposit check to the trip leader.
- 7. This year the signups will be done through U.S. Mail and Tuesday May 7, will be the start of the signup period for the 2025 ski trips. For lottery purposes, the initial signup will run through Tuesday May 14, 2024. All trip lottery policies will apply. Your post mark will secure your eligibility in a trip lottery should a trip over sell within the initial sign-up period. We will allow adequate time for mail in applications to be delivered to the trip leaders and all lotteries will be held on or after May 18,2024.
- 8. Your deposit is your vote to support your chosen trip(s) and trip leader(s).
- 9. We hope to once again have zoom meetings for all of our trips for potential trip participants to ask questions of the trip leaders. Watch for email blast for links to the Zoom meetings.

SKI THE BIG RED – NEW SSC DESTINATION RED MOUNTAIN, BRITISH COLUMBIA

January 11-18, 2025 Saturday to Saturday

Join SSC for an all-new skiing destination to Red Mountain, British Columbia, located in the little gold rush-era city of Rossland, just minutes over the US border. With five skiable peaks and massive terrain (3,850 acres), no lift lines here! Red Mountain is western Canada's oldest ski resort and ranks in the top 10 for total skiable acres in North America. They also boast an average of 25 feet of snow per year! You could opt to ski with a snow host and take advantage of in-bounds pay-per-run snowcat skiing. Lodging will be at the Josie Hotel which is ski in/ski out and offers a daily breakfast buffet. A five-day lift ticket is included in the package price, but if you already have an Ikon Pass or an Ikon Base Pass, you can use it for 7 or 5 days of skiing respectively at Red Mountain. A valid passport is required for entry into Canada. Flights will be from Baltimore to Spokane, Washington with bus transfers to the resort. Pricing is currently being finalized. VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITY IRONMAN 70.3 HAPPY VALLEY

Sunday, June 30, 2024

Sayer's Lake in Bald Eagle State Park, Howard, PA

We are looking for kayakers, canoers and SUPers to help at this year's Ironman 70.3. On Sunday, June 30, we need 65-70 boaters to line the race course at Sayer's Lake to help keep the swimmers safe and on course. Paddlers should be experienced in flat water paddling, and be able to remain calm and focused during the race. The race is held rain or shine, Last year, the lake was calm (no wind), but the swimmers do create a wake as they swim by in masses. You need to keep your vessel in position as much as possible. There will be swimmers who will hang on to your boat to catch their breath for a few seconds/minutes, and swimmers who will veer off course (we guide them back on course). Instructions and video are provided in advance, and on the morning of the event, there is a safety meeting. Safety gear (whistles, flags & buoys) is provided, as well as hot coffee, refreshments and daily launch permits (for those who don't have one). Safety meeting starts at 5:30am (for those farther away, you may want to consider camping at the park the night before), with boats getting into position at 6:15am. Boaters are finished before 10:00am and may want to take advantage of the beautiful lake by having a leisurely paddle after the race.
